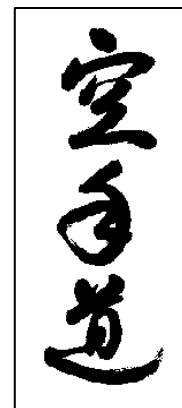

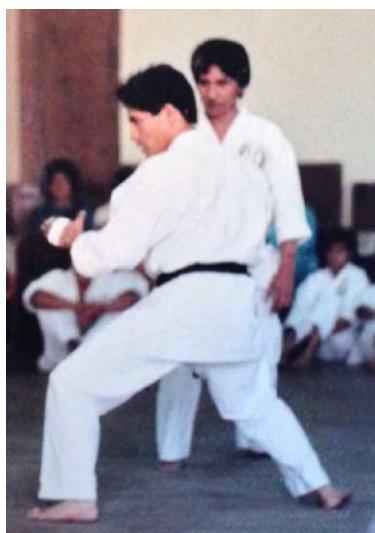

2023 - TKK Tournament Rules WKF

Rules with Modifications KATA

1. Beginner and Novice divisions must perform BASIC kata. Beginner and Novice divisions may repeat the same kata.
2. Intermediate and Advanced Divisions will be Tokui (free selection). But must perform a different kata in the medal rounds.
3. **ALL BLACK BELTS – WILL COMPETE FIRST**
4. All Kata to be judged by the flag system.
5. All Divisions, if contestant does an incomplete Kata, contestant may restart but cannot win the match. Except divisions 1, 3 & 5.

KUMITE

1. Kumite matches will begin immediately after the Kata competition has been completed.
2. Matches are to be scored with an 8 point ceiling (first to acquire 8 points wins)
3. All divisions are **STOP TIME**
 - a. Junior divisions: 17 years & under 1½ minutes
 - b. Adult divisions: 18+ years 2 minutes
 - c. Adult Men's Black Belt 3 minutes
 - d. Adult Women's Black Belt 2 minutes
4. Face techniques will be allowed in all divisions. **HOWEVER, NO CONTACT ALLOWED!!**
 - a. Face contact-**ALL JUNIOR DIVISIONS** 17 & under – Head contact must be penalized (KEIKOKU).
 - b. Excessive face contact for **ALL JUNIOR AND ADULT DIVISIONS** (draws blood, etc.) is an automatic disqualification (HANSOKU).
5. **MANDATORY - ALL CONTESTANTS MUST USE A MOUTHPIECE WHILE SPARRING OR THEY WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO COMPETE.** Men must wear cups. Women must wear chest protectors under their GI's. Hand protection must be worn.
6. Protection devices (hard shin pads, heavy tape, gloves, foot guards, or footpads) are NOT allowed. Contestants are responsible for providing their own hand protection. Headgear may be worn in any division, but contestants must provide their own. All contestants to provide their own mouth piece.
7. No spine or groin strikes allowed in any division. No inside sweeps, neck chops or elbow/knee strikes.
8. In the event of draw (Hikiwake) a decision (Hantei) **MUST BE MADE.**

**COACHES WILL BE PERMITTED ON THE COMPETITION FLOOR at \$20 FEE
SCHOOL PHOTOGRAPHERS MUST CHECK IN WITH TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR**
